WHY

- + With many office spaces downsizing to meet the needs of hybrid work practices, companies need space-conscious and versatile solutions. Gemelli accomplishes this by being light in scale without sacrificing style and durability.

- + There is an increased demand for products that can stand out as a centerpiece while simultaneously fitting into any space, aesthetic, and brand image.

HOW

- + Gemelli's unique design was inspired by the shape of a gentleman's cufflink, adding a unique and beautiful element that distinguishes the chair.
- + The curvature of Gemelli's poly shell was designed to reinforce the human body's natural seating position.

- + Gemelli is available as a guest model with or without arms.
- + Gemelli's poly shell is available in 6 finishes to suit any style or mood: Savoy, Soleil, Valley, Dune, Ashtone and Noir.
- + Gemelli features 7 frame finishes; a chrome frame paired with polished aluminum arms, as well as 6 paint colors.
- + Gemelli offers an optional upholstered seat pad for added comfort and enhanced visual options.
